Dr. Betsy Brothers is a distinguished, board-certified obstetrician and gynecologist who has served the Naples community since 2001. As a founding partner of the Southwest Florida Women's Group, she has dedicated over two decades to providing comprehensive healthcare, specializing in high-risk obstetrics, gynecology, and bioidentical hormones. Her leadership extends deeply into the NCH (Naples Comprehensive Health) system, where she currently serves as the OB/GYN Department Chair and OB/GYN Chief Medical Officer. In these pivotal roles, Dr. Brothers has been a primary advocate and clinical leader for the development of the Van Domelen Pavilion for Women and Children, a landmark \$300–\$350 million clinical center of excellence at NCH North.

Dr. Brothers has been a vocal champion for the Van Domelen Pavilion, emphasizing its critical role in expanding local access to specialized care, including Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) services and advanced maternal-fetal medicine. She has highlighted that the pavilion is not merely an expansion of beds, but a vital initiative to recruit the specialists and sub-specialists needed to keep high-risk families close to home rather than requiring travel to distant cities for care. Her academic foundation is equally robust; she graduated Summa Cum Laude from Louisiana State University, earned her medical degree from the LSU Health Sciences Center in New Orleans, and completed her residency at Vanderbilt University Medical Center.

Recognized as a Castle Connolly Top Doctor annually since 2012, Dr. Brothers continues to bridge the gap between private practice and visionary hospital leadership, ensuring the next generation of women and children in Southwest Florida receives world-class medical support.
